# 2022-2023 Federal and State Work-Study Calendar

#### **Summer Quarter:**

Classes in Session: July 5<sup>th</sup> -- August 18<sup>th</sup>

Summer Break: August 19<sup>th</sup> -- September 18<sup>th</sup>

Blackout Dates: September 16<sup>th</sup>—September 18<sup>th</sup>

#### **Fall Quarter:**

Classes in Session: September 19<sup>th</sup> — December 9<sup>th</sup>
Winter Break: December 10<sup>th</sup> — January 2<sup>nd</sup>
Blackout Dates: January 1<sup>st</sup> — January 2<sup>nd</sup>

#### Winter Quarter:

Classes in Session: January 3<sup>rd</sup> — March 17<sup>th</sup>

Spring Break: March 18<sup>th</sup> — April 2<sup>nd</sup>

Blackout Dates: April 1<sup>st</sup> — April 2<sup>nd</sup>

### **Spring Quarter:**

Classes in Session: April 3<sup>rd</sup> —June 16<sup>th</sup>

Pre-Summer Break: June 17<sup>th</sup> — June 30<sup>th</sup>

## **Work-Study Eligibility:**

- Must be registered for a minimum of 6 credits each quarter
- Must be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Must have available financial need and have been awarded Work-Study

If at any point during their employment a student fails to meet any of these requirements they must <u>immediately</u> stop working.

## **Available Work Hours:**

- While Class is in Session: 19 hours per week maximum
- During Quarter Breaks: 40 hours per week maximum

Students must work with their supervisors to create a schedule that ensures they will not work beyond their awarded hours. If a student does work beyond what they were awarded, note that the funds will be subtracted from that supervisor's departmental budget.
